



## The Stanley Cup

**18<sup>th</sup>, 19<sup>th</sup> & 20<sup>th</sup> August 2022**

Held under the General Regulations of Motorsport UK  
(incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA)  
and these Supplementary Regulations.

### **Supplementary Regulations**

1. The Frazer Nash Car Club will organise the Stanley Cup Competition on Thursday, Friday and Saturday the 18<sup>th</sup>, 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> August 2022. This will be a closed event and will only be open to teams of three cars driven by members of the organising Club. A list of entrants will be published by the organisers, however **Competitors are responsible for forming their own teams.**

The start and finish will be at the Stone Hurst Farm, Mountsorrel Leicestershire, LE12 7AA (MR 129/576144).

The event comprises road sections and tests held on private land.

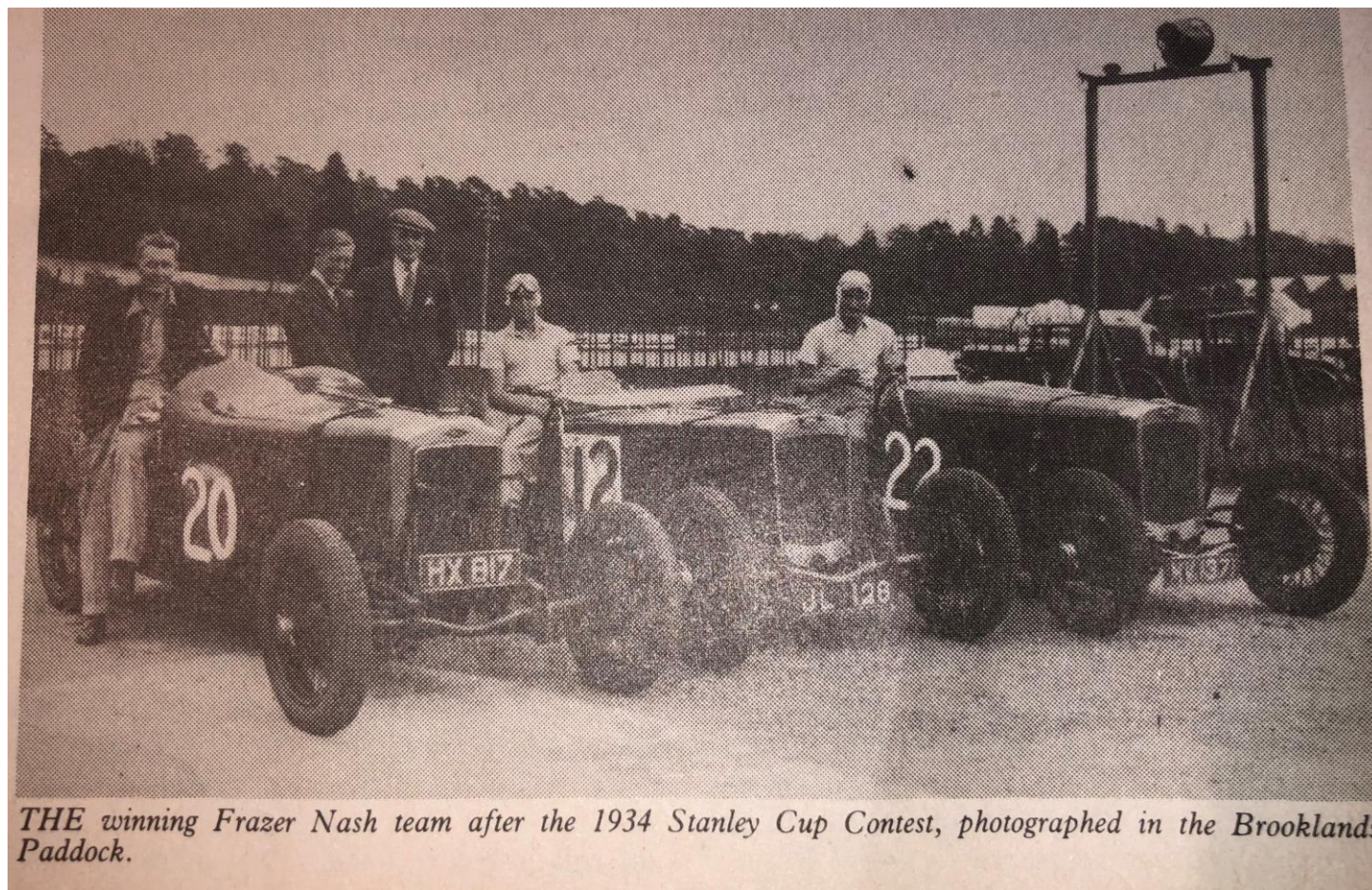
Please note that this is a charity event and a donation will be made to the Red Cross on behalf of the entrants.

2. The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising Club may issue for the event.
3. MSUK Permit Number - TBA
4. The event is a Clubman's event open to all fully paid up members (including associate members) of the Frazer Nash Car Club.
5. All competitors must be fully paid-up members of the organising Club.
6. All competitors, including navigators/co-drivers need to have a current 2022 Motorsport UK RS Clubman Competition License (unless you have a Race or Speed licence for 2022) these are free, mandatory, and issued by our governing body. You can apply online at MSUK <https://rsclubman.motorsportuk.org/>
7. The Programme of the meeting will be as follows:
  - Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> August 18.00 Signing on and Scrutineering open.
  - Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> August 18.30 Tests open.
  - Friday 19<sup>th</sup> August 08.30 – First team depart Stonehurst Farm.
  - Friday 19<sup>th</sup> August 18.00 -Last team finishes at Stonehurst Fam.
  - Saturday 20<sup>th</sup> August 08.30 First team depart Stonehurst Farm.
  - Saturday 20<sup>th</sup> August 15.00 – Last team finishes at Stonehurst Farm.There will be a bar and food at Stonehurst Farm on the evenings of 18<sup>th</sup> August and 19<sup>th</sup> August
8. There will be no classes in this event.
9. Entries open on the publication of these regulations and close finally on Sunday 24 July 2022. The entry fee is £101.00, reduced to £50.00 for drivers under the age of 30. All entries must be made on the official entry form and be accompanied by the appropriate fee. Entries will be accepted on a first come first served basis

11. The maximum entry for the event is 90, no reserves will be taken. The minimum is 30 with the minimum for each class being six. Should any of the stated minimum figures not be reached, the organisers have the right to cancel the meeting or amalgamate classes as necessary
12. Provisional results will be announced by 20.00 pm on Saturday and will be published in accordance with D26.1.3
13. Any protest or appeal must be lodged in accordance with C5 or C6 as appropriate. .
14. Details of the routes and will be issued on the day.
15. Details of the tests will be issued on the day. Each driver will have one run to count for results. The starting signal will be a flag. Order of attempting tests will be notified in the Competitors' Instructions. All tests must be completed with both the driver and the navigator / co driver in the car.
16. Competitors will be identified by numbers which will be provided by the organisers and should be displayed on the front and rear of the car.
17. Entries will be acknowledged upon receipt of a valid entry form (D16.1). Competitors' Instructions will be emailed or posted between seven and ten days prior to the event. Any further instructions will be issued at signing-on. Driver or car changes shown from that on the published entry list can only be sanctioned by writing to the Clerk of the Course. Requests for such changes should be submitted to the Secretary of the Meeting in accordance with D25.1.12
18. In accordance with H24, all entrants are reminded that they should abstain from the consumption of alcohol or drugs and that defaulter(s) may be excluded under D25.1.14.
19. It is recommended that all vehicles are equipped with fire extinguishers and spill kits which comply with current Motor Sport UK specifications.
