



THE FRAZER NASH CAR CLUB LTD

GENERAL INFORMATION SHEET

The FRAZER NASH CAR CLUB, founded in 1933, became a Section of the Vintage Sports Car Club in 1948 and was re-formed in December 2005 as the Frazer Nash Car Club Limited (FNCC), an independent company, limited by guarantee.

Its purpose is to encourage the preservation of chain-driven Frazer Nash and GN cars, to maintain a register of all existing cars and to facilitate the interchange of technical information and spares.

Membership

There are five classes of membership:

HONORARY	awarded by a majority vote at an AGM.
FULL	limited to owners of chain-driven Frazer Nash and GN cars as well as post-war Frazer Nash cars built up to 1957
ASSOCIATE	open to past or prospective owners of FN and GN chain drive cars and owners of Frazer Nash BMW cars.
JUNIOR	Under 21 years.
FAMILY	open to partners of members.

Only Full Members have voting rights and may hold office in the Club.

The annual subscription is currently £30.00 for Full and Associate Members and £5.00 for Family Members. Junior Members pay only 50% of the current subscription and the entry fee is waived. There is an entry fee of £5.00 for everyone over the age of 21. Overseas Members pay a subscription of £40.00 to cover the extra cost of airmail postage. **Sterling cheques payable to FNCC Ltd.**

Subscriptions are due on 1st January each year but for those joining on or after October 1st the subscription will cover the ensuing year.

Competition

The Club encourages Members to enter their cars in all types of competition and we are registered with the MSA. We have a large number of annual aggregate trophies and there are also various awards for the best performances by 'Nashes' in VSCC events.

Spares

There is an active spares scheme for the manufacture of new parts to the original specifications and many items are held in stock. This scheme is only available to Members.

Social Events

Functions are held from time to time. There is a Summer Picnic and early in December each year we hold the famous Christmas Party. Every ten years there is a Raid to the South Tyrol - the next one will be in 2019 - other Raids are held annually either at home or overseas.

The Frazer Nash Car Club maintains a Register of both pre-and post-war cars and this information is accessible. GN, Frazer Nash and AFN together produced a relatively small number of cars, which means that we have detailed information on nearly every one in existence. If you are interested in buying one of these cars and particularly if you plan to participate in Club events and competitions, you would be advised to make yourself fully aware about the vehicle before you make a commitment - especially as a number of more recently produced replicas are in existence.
